REDBANK RUN: 4WD TAG-ALONG TOUR

This full day tour will take you to some of the less visited areas of Yanga not normally accessible to the public. Traverse the length of the River Redgum forest along the parks Murrumbidgee River frontage. Please bring food, water and enough fuel to cover 100km or more. High clearance diesel 4WD vehicles preferred. This tour is subject to road & weather conditions.
