JACKAROO'S TOUR

Enjoy learning about Yanga's pastoral past while your guide shows you the historic treasures of the 1870s-drop log homestead. Explore the beautiful formal rose gardens and marvel at the stunning 1200ha Yanga Lake.

HEART OF YANGA: FORESHORE WALK

Immerse yourself in the unique ecosystem of Yanga Lake with guided walk around our 1km loop track. Learn about the importance of this freshwater source and marvel at the abundance of plants & wildlife from the Red-gum bird hide.

High clearance diesel 4WD vehicles preferred. This tour is subject to road & weather conditions.
