REDBANK RUN: 4WD TAG-ALONG TOUR

Guided by NPWS park rangers, this is a unique opportunity to tour the hidden wonders of Yanga National Park's River Redgum wetlands. Visit areas of Yanga not normally accessible to the public in the comfort of your own car, follow the twists and turns of the Murrumbidgee River and see hidden creeks, swamps and lakes.

Please bring food, water and enough fuel to cover 100km or more. High clearance diesel 4WD vehicles preferred.

Meet at the park office Yanga Homestead 9:30am, this tour aims to return by 3pm.

Yanga Homestead is located just 8km south east of Balranald on the Sturt Highway and is well signposted.
