Business Arising:

1. Dietes Bicolor [5] and Dietes Grandiflora (wild iris) [10] to be planted in median strips by Committee.
This has now been completed – looks great!
2. Chinese Elms [6] - ~3m-high (3yo) Murray's Form trees have been sourced. Arrangements for freight are currently underway.
3. Red Ficifolias [13] - 1.4m-high (1yo) are ordered and will arrive around the 30th August. These will be planted with the assistance from Parks and Gardens Council staff.
Traffic control plans and inductions will be required by all committee members and volunteers.

New Business:

1. Cemetery Rose Planting – donated roses are to be planted in a line at the cemetery. Plans of where they are proposed to be planted are required. Reticulation hoses/fittings for these roses will likely be purchased from Bodinnars.
Note: Raw water at the cemetery is presently (as of 16th August) disabled until repairs can be completed.
