INVESTIGATION WORK ON SWAN HILL BRIDGE

Motorists are advised changed traffic conditions will be in place from next Tuesday on Swan Hill Bridge for investigation work on the bridge piers.

The work will be carried out on Tuesday 16 and Wednesday 17 January from 7am to 4pm and 10pm to 6am, weather permitting.

Motorists could experience delays of up to 10 minutes during the day and up to 30 minutes in the evening while work is carried out.

To minimise disruption to motorists, work which could result in longer delays will be carried out after midnight.

Motorists should be aware there is a 3.1 metre width restriction on the Swan Hill bridge and all wider vehicles should use the Nyah Bridge, which will add around 45 minutes to a journey.

For the safety of workers and motorists, lane closures and a reduced speed limit of 20 km/h will be in place during work hours and may affect travel times.

Motorists are advised to follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs and keep to the reduced speed limit.
