My Community Projects: How to Vote.

From 15 July 2019, you can have your say on what projects are funded in your local area. My Community Project will fund projects in each NSW electorate to help improve the wellbeing of the people and communities that live there. It might be new playground equipment or sports facilities for the kids, paths or ramps to improve access, an art installation to rejuvenate an empty space or a community transport service.

Voting will be open for four weeks from 15 July to 15 August 2019. If you live in NSW and are 16 years or older, you'll be able to vote for the projects in your electorate.

You'll be able to vote online or at your nearest Service NSW Centre. To vote, you'll need:



a <u>MyServiceNSW Account(external link)</u> – if you do not have an account, <u>sign up on the Service NSW website(external link)</u>, call 13 77 88 or visit a <u>Service NSW centre(external link)</u>



Your Medicare card to verify your name and age



Your NSW residential address to identify your electorate

<u>You'll need to pick between three and five projects in your electorate</u>, arrange them in order of your preference, and then submit your vote. Each person can vote only once.
