Works Manager to do stocktake on available signs It was agreed that this would be erected on the Brian Smith Stand at Greenham Park.

• Committee would like to endorse that the name Lions Park be kept but a new sign is required.

DID has called for quotes for new sign.

• Jill has advised there is no kerb access for people with walking frames and wheelchairs etc., to access memorial walk along Court St.

• Steve advised that the bamboo at the swing bridge needs to be cut back.

DID to check if a work order is required.

• Mary asked if the sign for the archway for babies of itinerant workers could be erected.
