

## EMERGENCY SERVICES ACCESS DURING BRIDGE WORK

### Kyalite Bridge, Kyalite

Transport for NSW is carrying out essential maintenance work on Kyalite Bridge on the Yanga Way over Wakool River at Kyalite.

This work will involve repairing bridge joints and abutment, setting up access, resurfacing the bridge deck, upgrading the current bridge guardrail and other bridge maintenance work.

Work will be carried out from 7am to 6pm weekdays from Monday 20 September and is expected to be completed on Friday 19 November, weather permitting.

Traffic on the bridge will be under the direction of temporary traffic lights and reduced to 40 km/h and a single lane for the duration of the work.

The bridge will be closed for up to 20 minutes during various stages of the work. To limit impacts on the community, these will occur as required between 10am and 2pm, removing the need for a long detour and full bridge closure while the work is carried out.

In the event of an emergency, Transport will stop work, remove equipment from the bridge and provide clear access for emergency services.

To allow Transport to provide access as quickly as possible, we ask you to follow this procedure:

1. Call Transport construction team members to request clear access to the bridge as soon as possible. Contact details are as follows:

2. When in range, contact Transport staff on UHF Radio Channel No 13
3. If Transport staff are unable to be contacted or are not contacted in advance, we will provide access as soon as possible when emergency services vehicle(s) arrive at the bridge.

In order to update our project contact register, we request that you respond to this letter with the most appropriate contact details for ongoing correspondence regarding these bridge works.

It is preferable that we receive one set of contact details for each depot affected by the work to ensure that our correspondence continues to reach appropriate personnel in the event of staff changes.

We also request that you distribute this correspondence within your internal networks to affected parties. If there are any changes to the above procedure, Transport will issue further correspondence.

## What are we doing?

We are carrying out maintenance work on Kyalite Bridge on the Yanga Way over Wakool River at Kyalite, to ensure the bridge remains safe and serviceable well into the future.


There will be temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe.

During this time, bridge traffic will be reduced to a single lane with traffic lights in place to guide road users across the bridge and a 40 km/h speed limit will be in place.
