INFRASTRUCTURE REPORT

Regional Roads

Heavy patching works on MR67 (Balranald-Ivanhoe Road) within the Balranald Shire are ongoing. Road damage from heavy vehicles continues to occur. Work continuing with contractor and council staff patching.

Unsealed Road Maintenance

Marma Box Creek Road and Clare Freshwater Road surfaces are being treated with Polytahr.

Flood Damaged Roads


Oxley Road (MR514)

Work has commenced on the addition of Polytahr to the surface of MR514, to assist in making the road more user friendly after rain, allowing the road to dry out much faster as the moisture does not penetrate the pavement. Works will continue in to July.

Antonio Drive, Euston

Reconstruction work has been carried out after flood waters subsided and the ground had dried out enough to repair. The pavement was stabilised with 'Triple Blend', compacted, graded and sealed.

Road Construction

Gravel construction works have commenced on 2km of Marma Box Creek Road.

FOOTPATH REPLACEMENT

Footpath replacement/construction works funded by round three of the Local Community and Infrastructure (LRCI) program have continued.

Balranald

Works continued in June on the replacement of 800m of footpaths along Market Street in Balranald. The footpaths chosen for these works were in poor condition. These paths have been widened to allow improved pedestrian, bicycle, wheelchair, gopher and pram access. Works will continue into July.

Euston

An additional 600m of new footpaths have been constructed:

- 1) West side of Sturt Highway, between the Euston Motel and Euston roundabout; and
- 2)East side of Sturt Highway, from Euston roundabout to the Euston Robinvale walking track.



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








KERBSIDE PICKUP RETURNS!
