The NSW SES advises people in the following area(s) to **MONITOR CONDITIONS** for forecast damaging winds:

- Deniliquin
- Hay
- Balranald
- Finley
- Jerilderie

### What are we expecting?

The Bureau of Meteorology advises a vigorous cold front and associated upper trough are bringing fast moving gusty thunderstorms to southern parts.

Severe thunderstorms are likely to produce damaging winds in the warning area over the next several hours.

This event may change quickly. We will monitor the situation and update our warnings if the situation changes.

### What you need to do:

- Avoid unnecessary travel, move indoors, bring children and pets with you.
- Park your car under secure cover and away from trees, powerlines and drains.
- If safe to do so, secure or put away items, such as outdoor furniture, trampolines and roofing iron that could blow around in strong winds.
- Grab your emergency kit in case you lose power or need to leave your home.
